Background

The Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS) is a national school-based survey that monitors health risk behaviors that contribute to the leading causes of death and disability among youth and young adults. These include:

- Behaviors that contribute to unintentional injuries and violence;
- Sexual behaviors;
- Substance use;
- Unhealthy dietary behaviors; and,
- Inadequate physical activity.

The YRBS also measures other high priority health-related behaviors and protective factors. These include:

- Prevalence of obesity;
- Attitudes and perceptions related to substance use;
- Food and housing insecurity;
- Youth assets;
- Academic achievement; and,
- Sexual identity and sex of sexual contacts.

Newton Public Schools engaged with John Snow, Inc. (JSI), a public health consulting firm, to support this initiative. Newton Public Schools and JSI worked to develop, administer, and analyze the middle and high school surveys.

Sample

In February 2023, the Student Health Survey was administered to all high school and middle school students. The data were cleaned and surveys not included in the final analysis when a student started but did not complete any of the questions, completed less than 50% of the questions, or took less than 50% of the average time to complete the survey.

Overall, 71% of high school students (N=2790) and 89% of middle school students (N=2486) were included in the analyses.

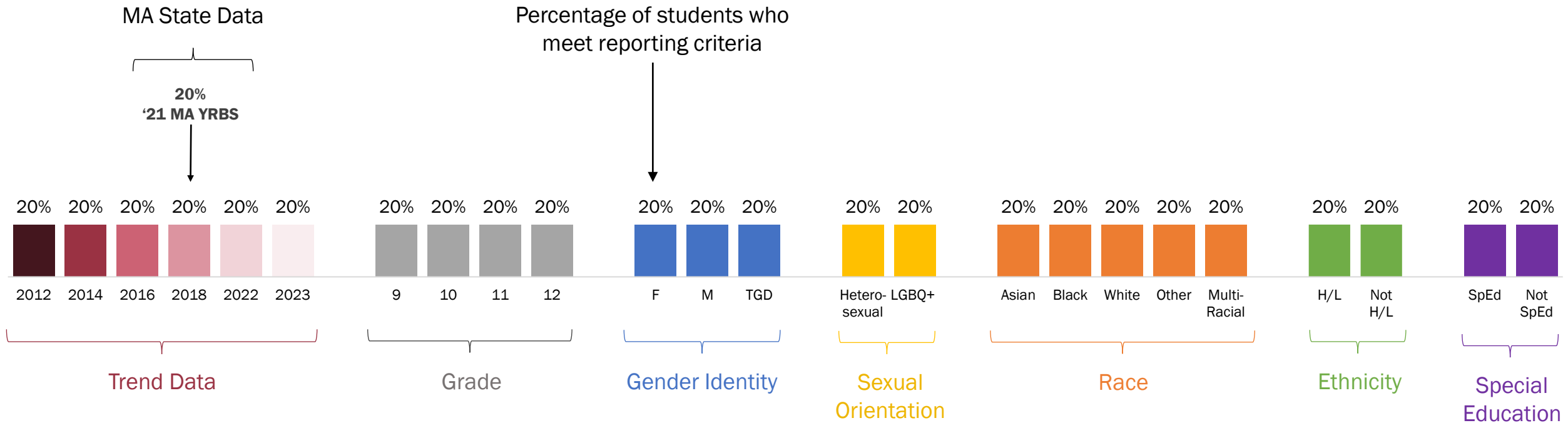

Reporting on the YRBS

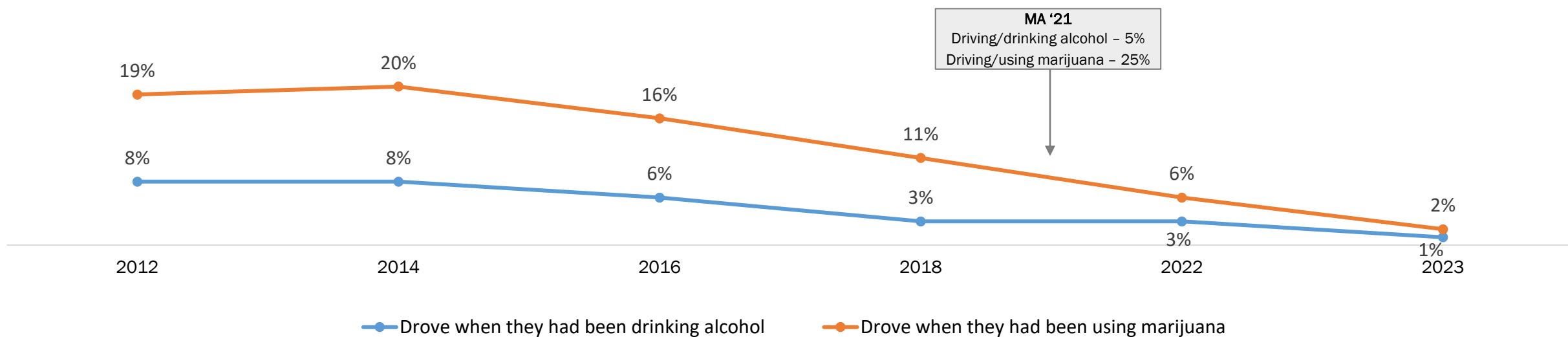
Throughout this report, we show differences by grade, gender identity, race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, and special education. Some students have a higher prevalence of many health-risk behaviors. These are noted throughout the report as being more or less likely to report the behavior than another group. In addition, changes over time and comparisons to 2021 Massachusetts data are noted.

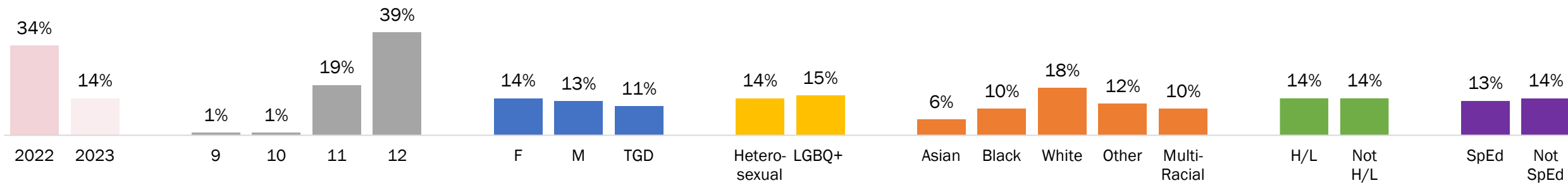
During the past 30 days, how many times did you drive a car or other vehicle when you had been drinking alcohol?

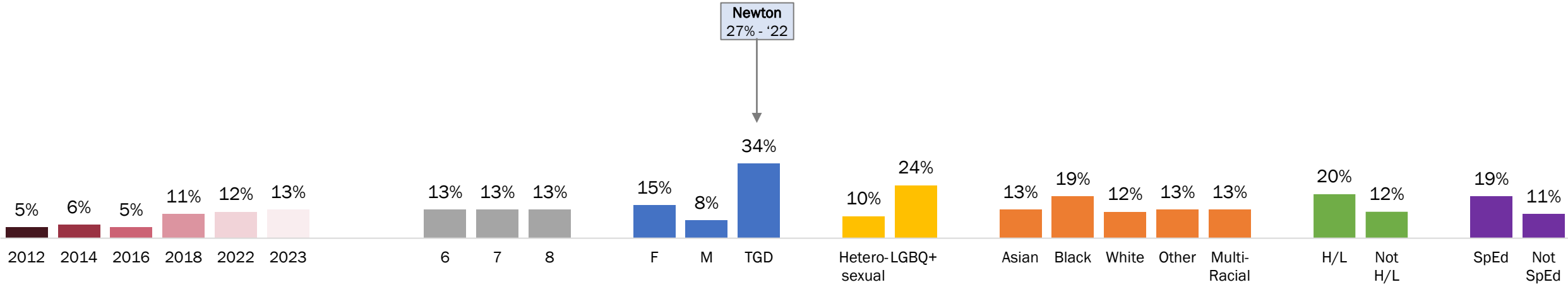

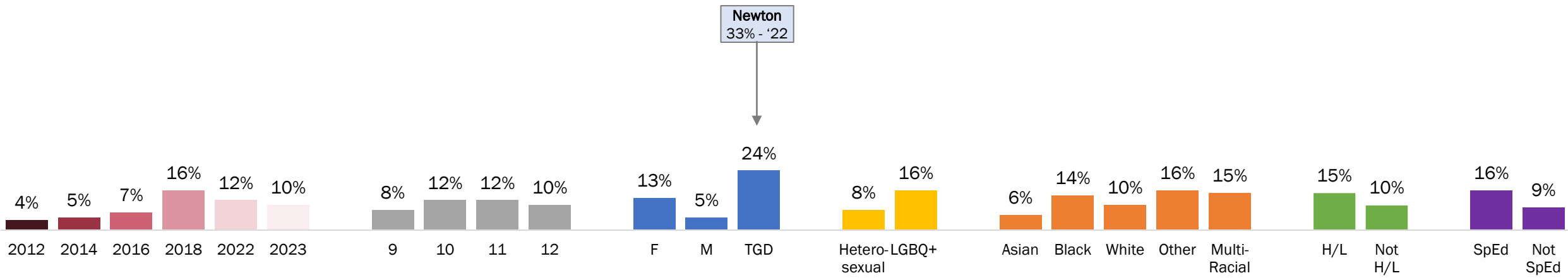
To what extent do you worry about your safety when you are in school?

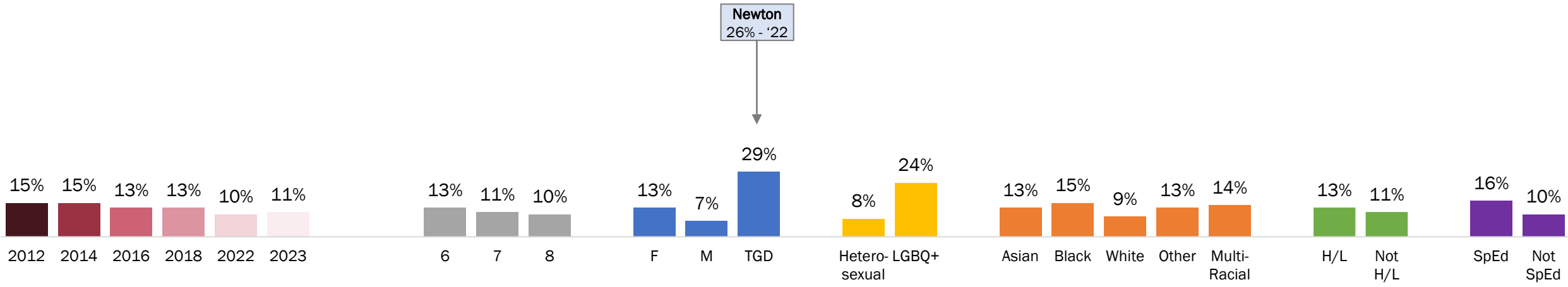

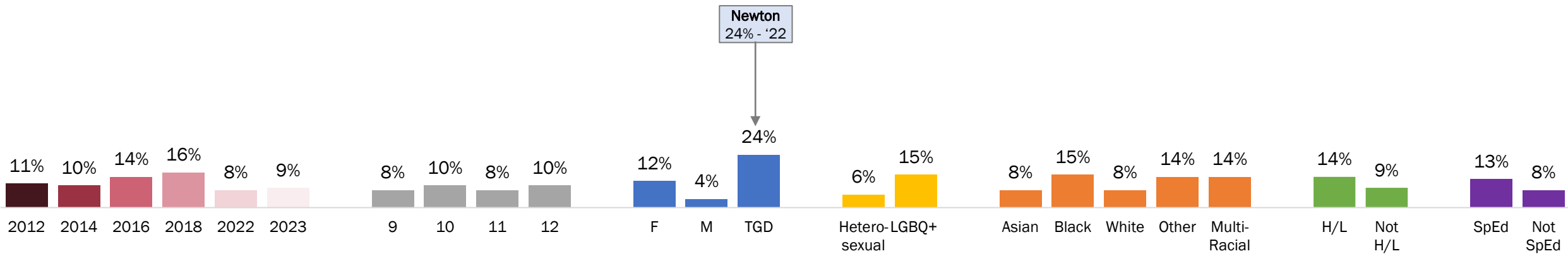


To what extent do you worry about your safety when you are not in school? (somewhat worried, very worried)

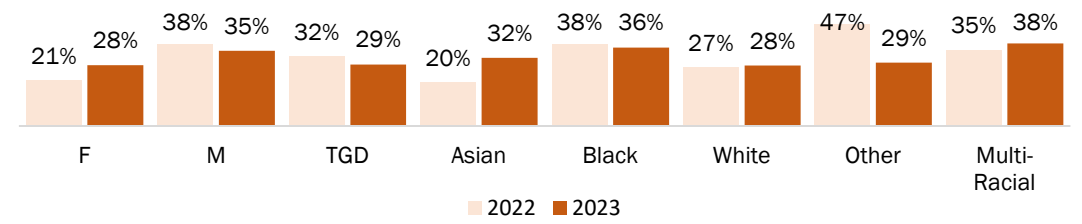
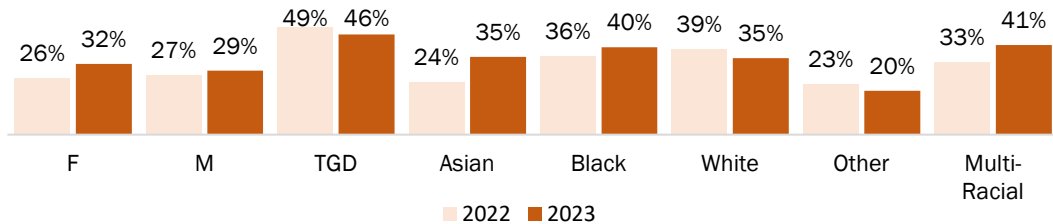
During the past 12 months, how often have you felt that you were treated badly or unfairly in school because of your race or ethnicity?



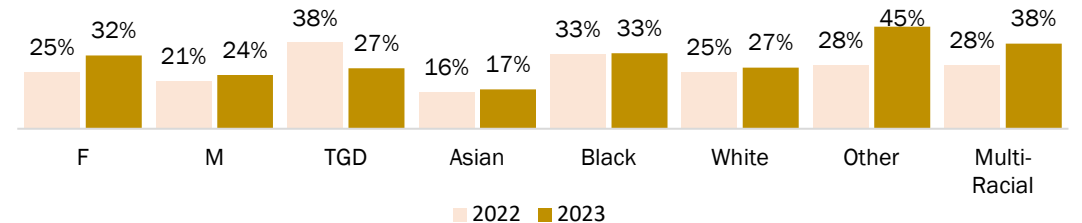
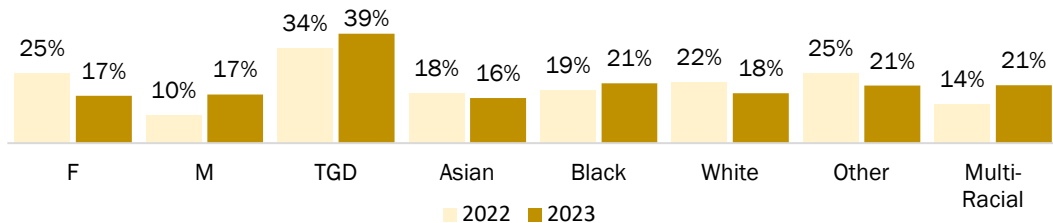
During the past 12 months, how often have you felt that you were treated badly or unfairly in school because of your gender identity?

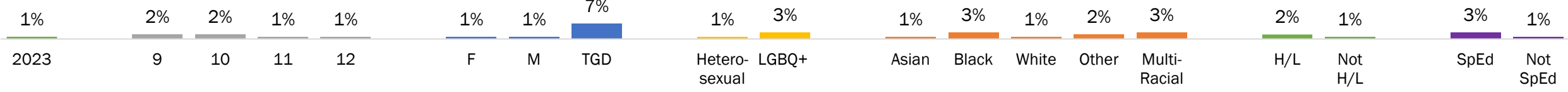

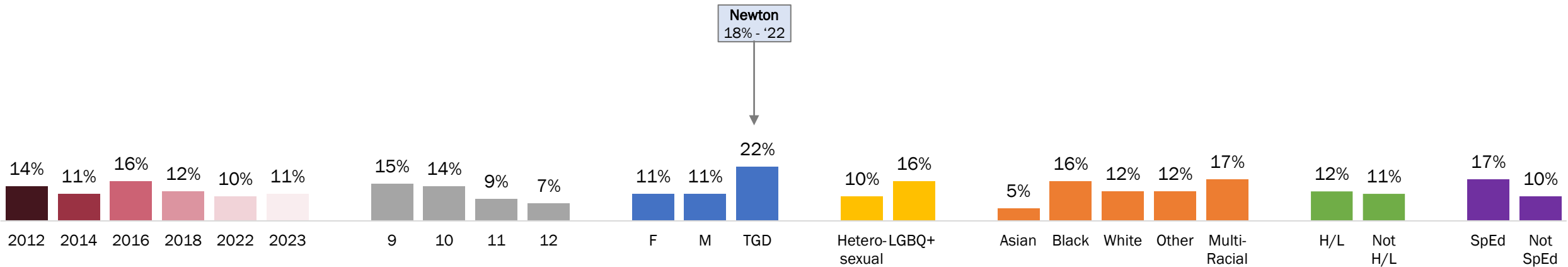


During the past 30 days, on how many times were you bullied in school? (1 or more times)

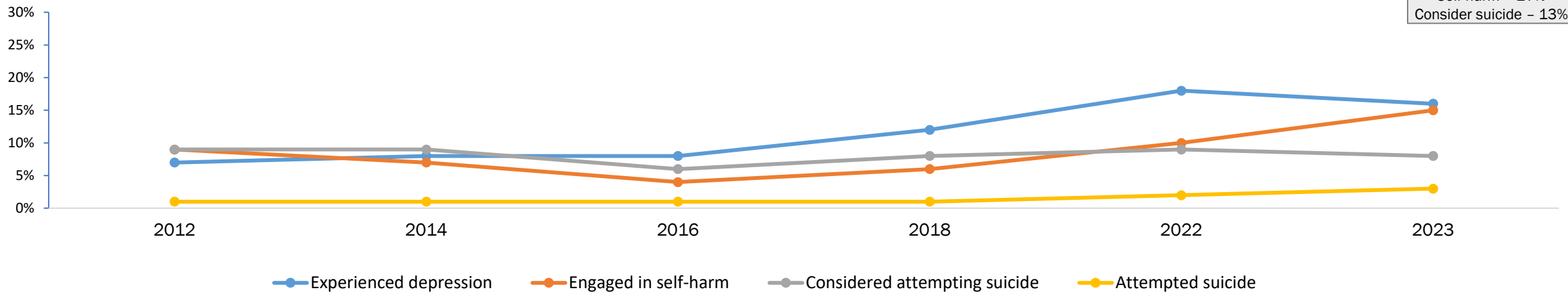

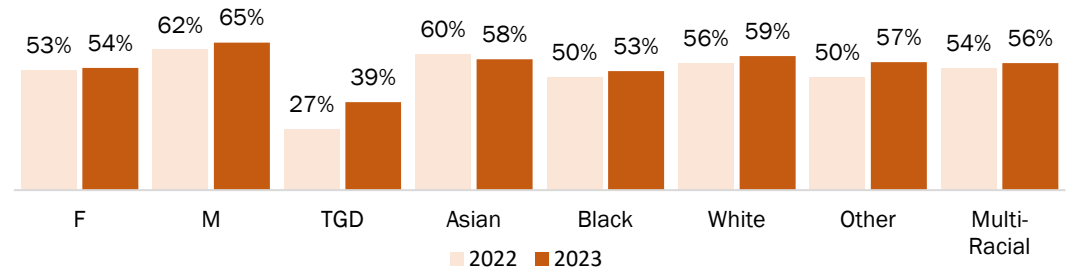
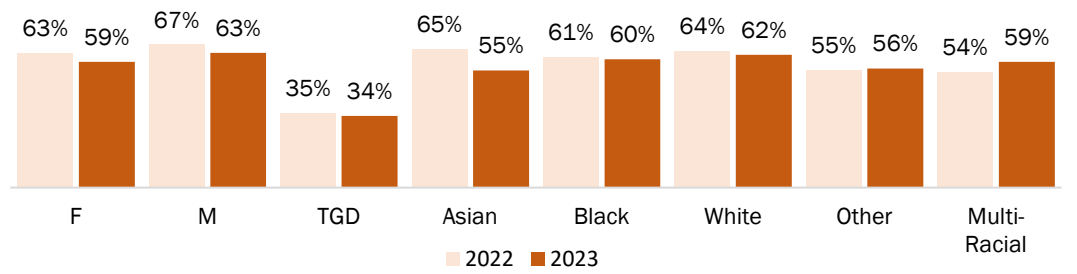
How much do you agree or disagree that you feel close to people at this school?

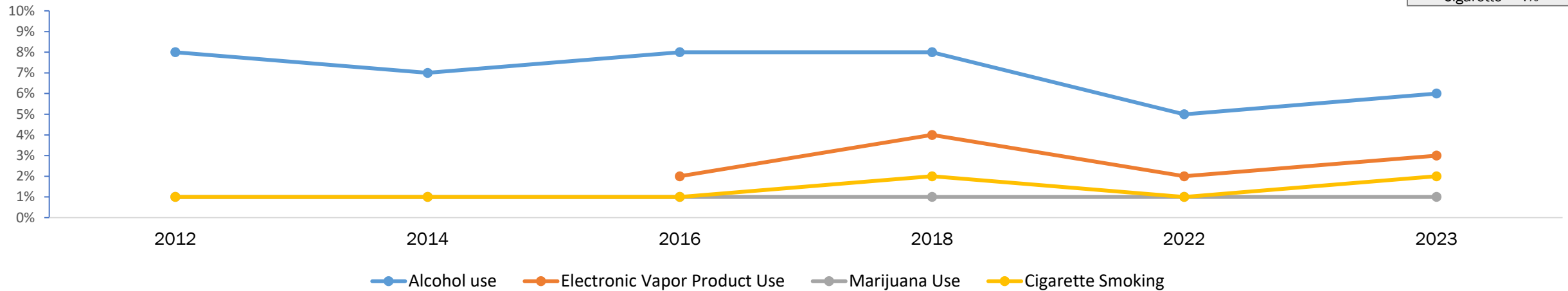


How much do you agree or disagree that you feel like I am part of this school?

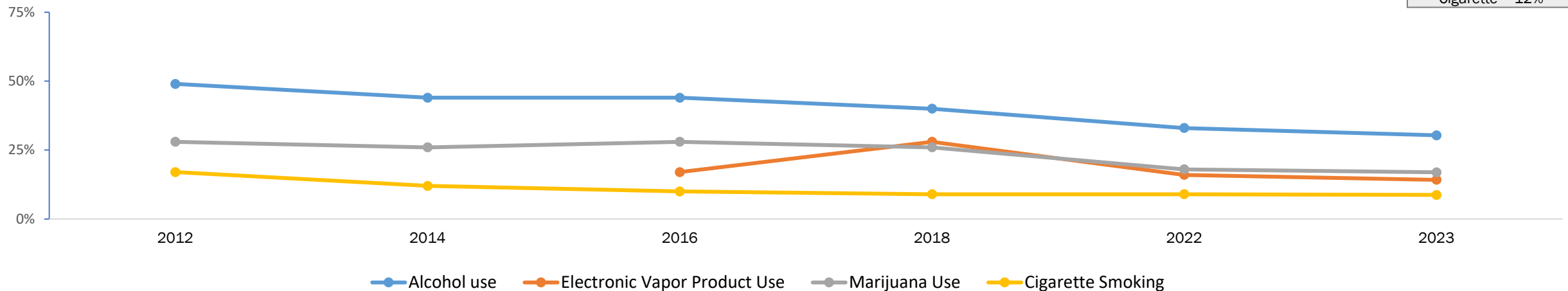

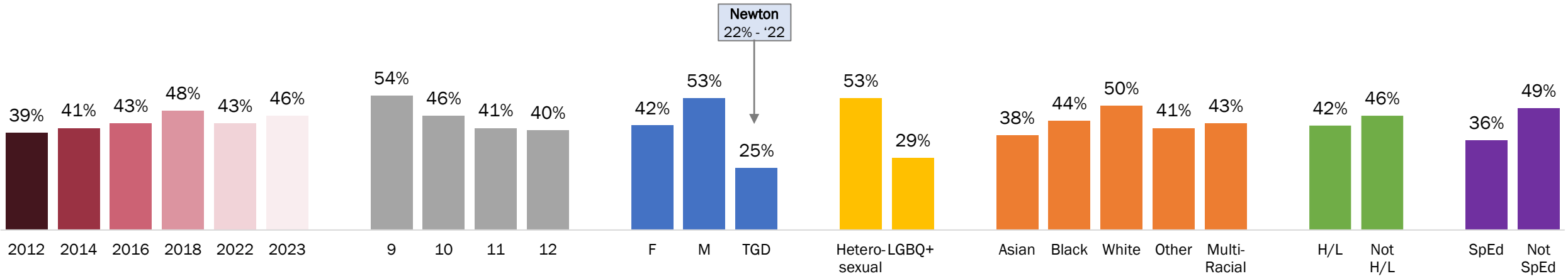


During the past 7 days, on how many days were you physically active for a total of at least 60 minutes per day? (5 or more days)

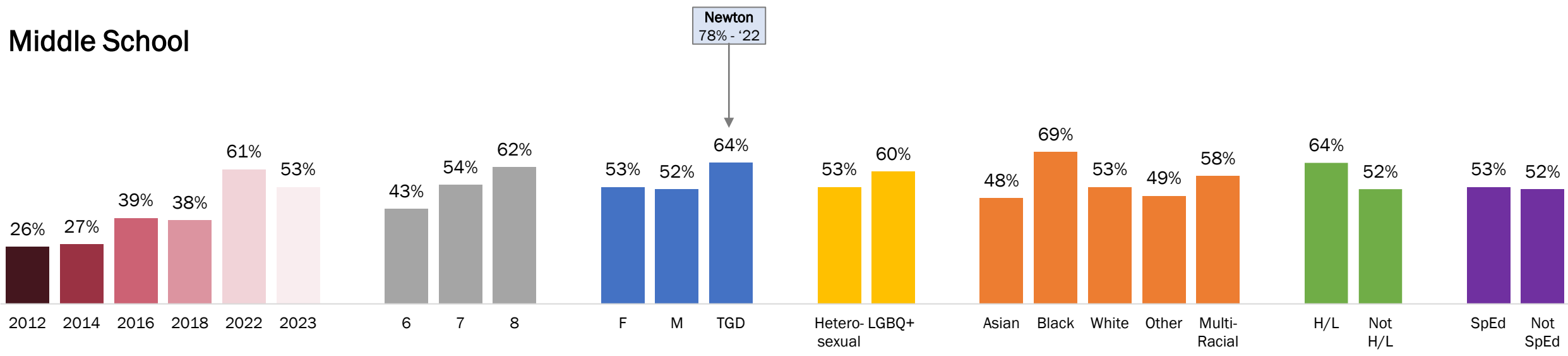

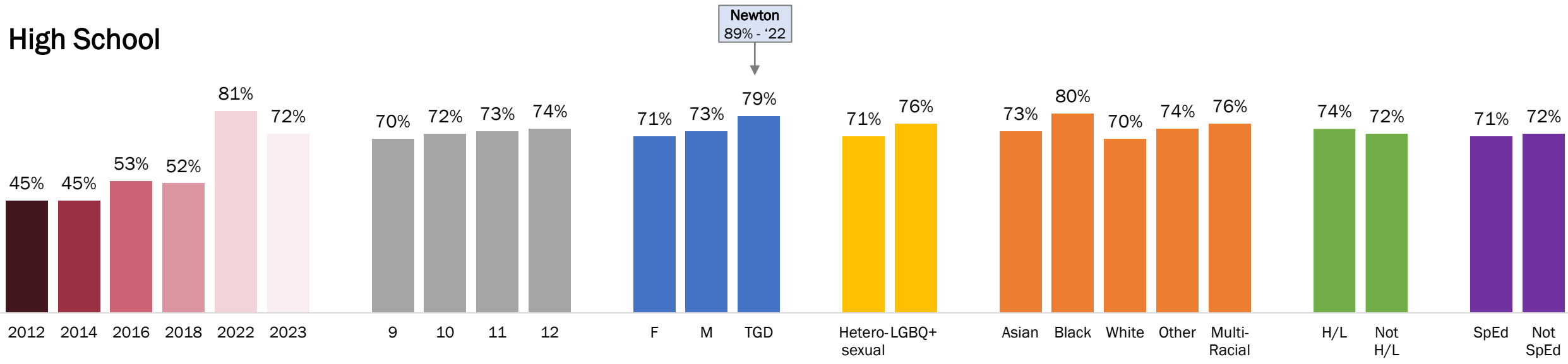


On an average school day, how many hours do you spend in front of a TV or on a computer, smartphone, or other electronic device doing things other than schoolwork? (3 or more hours)

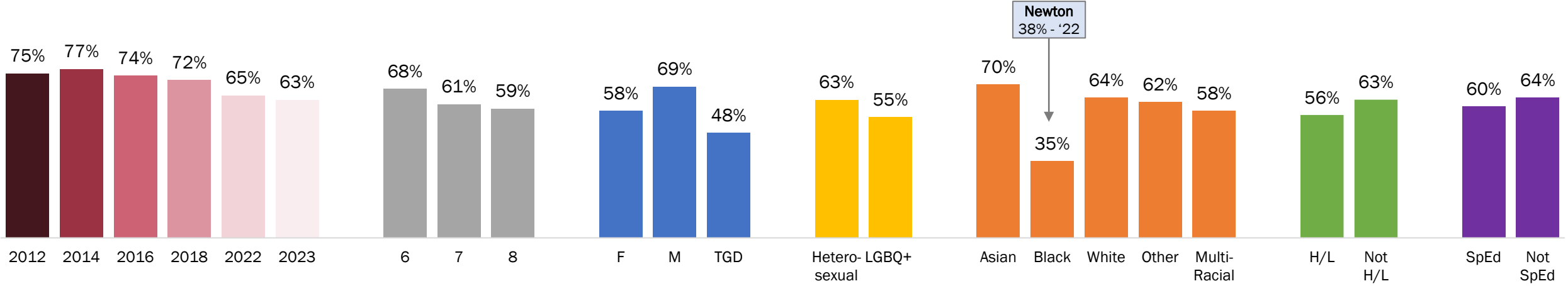

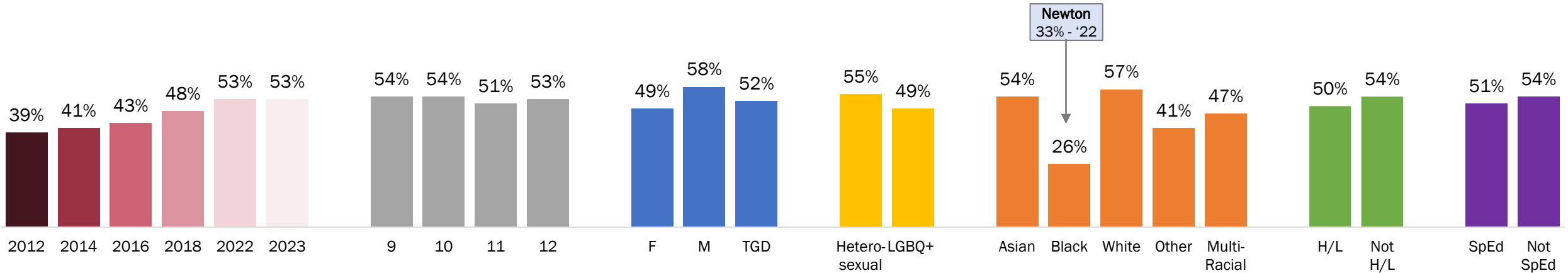


On how many of the past 7 days did you eat breakfast? (6 or 7 days)

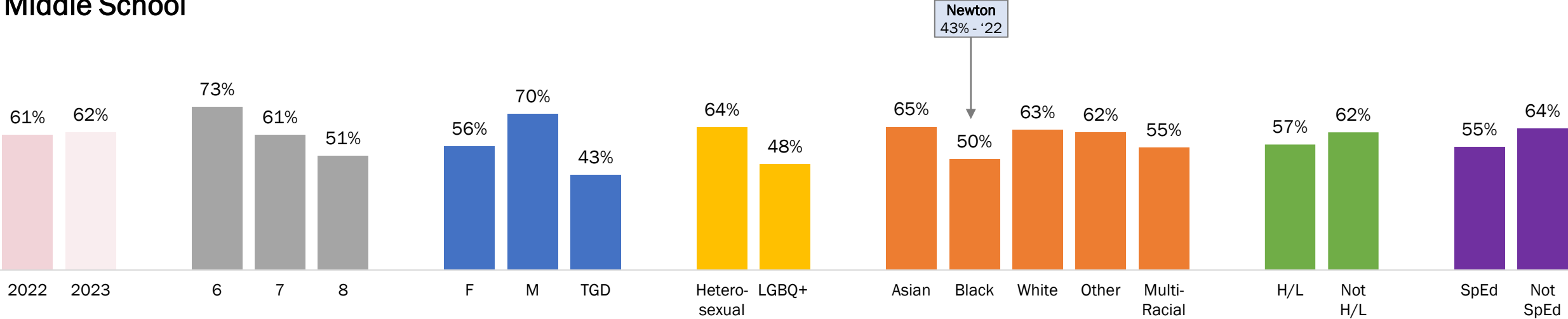
