Travel and study abroad are invaluable components of a student’s education, especially in today’s increasingly global world. Scholarships are available for students with demonstrated financial need through the Jennifer Price Global Education Fund (GELF).

INTERNATIONAL:

NSHS Argentina Exchange (San Rafael, Mendoza, Argentina) –Language & culture-focused homestay. Newton students will live with host families in San Rafael, Argentina and attend classes with their hosts at the Colegio del Carmen school. Students will also participate in cultural excursions led by Newton Spanish teachers. Students will also host their Argentinian peers in Newton for two weeks.
