RE: FY24 Grant Awards

I am pleased to inform you of the following FY24 and FY25 grant awards to the Newton Public Schools and request that the School Committee vote to accept these funds.

The Genocide Education Grant provided the option to apply for funding in both FY24 and FY25. Newton's strategy was developed for implementation starting this summer, so our award is for FY25 funds.

Newton applied for \$20,000 on the School Nutrition Equipment Assistance for Schools, which we were awarded. However, the funding has been approved using two different funding sources that DESE has allocated to Newton to provide the full award.
