Visitors see and hear first hand the accounts of survivors, Hedy Bohm and Nate Leipciger followed by a brief history of the Holocaust. The film then connects recent news to the jarring reality of similar events more than 80 years ago.

The presentation concludes with an empowering self reflection and call to action to the viewer.
