# West Newton Cinema Community Preservation Funding

#### Project Summary and Eligibility

- The West Newton Cinema Foundation (WNCF) has requested \$1,997,000 in CPA funding. This funding will include:
  - roof replacement
  - the replacement and repair of all egress doors
  - electric service upgrade
  - interior and exterior insulation
  - upgraded water service
  - interior work in the lobby and vestibule will address water damage
- This building is eligible to receive Historic Resource funds as it is listed on the National Register of Historic laces as part of the West Newton Historic District. All the work described in the application is eligible as it falls under the Sec. Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation.

- At the Community Preservation Committee meeting for the previous phase of work, both committee members and members of the public raised an issue of how the Cinema could better serve as a community space, when four out of the six theater, the bathrooms, and the event space upstairs all require the use of stairs.
- For this phase of work, the WNCF is preparing for eventual accessibility improvements through building stabilization work and electrical upgrades. Elevator installation is anticipated in the next phase of work.
